

A Look Back at 2022

In 2022, BFPA returned to normal in May, by celebrating its first official Dog Adoption Event since 2020. The cats, being in the adoption center, have been able to see more visitors. While we are all rejoicing in these changes, the impact to rescue hasn't been all good. As people returned to their post-pandemic lives, many stopped fostering and others began surrendering the very pets that gave them solace during the isolation. These trends, plus the fact that so many adopted a pet in the past 2 years, has made it challenging to get even young lab mix puppies adopted, which is unprecedented. Despite this, we have saved 95 cats and 105 dogs in 2022. THANKS to a core set of supporters, whether it be our working Board of Directors, our avid fundraisers, our fosters who always take the next one in, or our donors with their financial support, we have been able to continue our mission: to never turn away or euthanize an animal due to the expense involved in returning them to good health. The Prevalence of Parvo

In the world of rescue, one of the most dreaded phrases to hear from a vet is "Parvo Positive". Canine parvovirus (commonly referred to as "parvo") is one of the most serious viruses that dogs can get, and it usually preys on very young puppies whose immune systems haven't fully developed and/or who haven't been able to receive their entire DHPP vaccination series. This virus is easily transmitted in a shelter environment because it is highly contagious. At the end of the summer, BFPA rescued the "Breakfast Puppies" litter. During the normal 14 day quarantine period, several

of the pups started showing Parvo symptoms. Two of the five puppies (Jelly and Muffin) required expensive hospitalization at an emergency facility for several



days in order to save their lives.

Thanks to generous donations from our supporters, we were able to treat and save the entire litter — all of whom are now adopted!

95 Kitties and Counting

In 2022 so far, 95 kitties (and counting) have found their way into BFPA's amazing foster homes this year. The team of cat caretakers and fosters have taken on numerous kittens with many of the common medical issues we find in rescue situations, such as upper respiratory infections, digestive issues, ringworm, and malnourishment. Often times, all these kittens need is some TLC, short courses of medical treatment

and adequate nourishment to help them thrive and grow into healthy and happy cats. We did have some scary and more critical cases this year, including a few with injured/broken legs that needed surgery to repair and a couple which required amputation.

While there have been some very tough days and weeks for the team this



year, every time we get to deliver a kitty to a waiting family, the struggle is diminished and our mission comes back into focus. One kitty goes to its forever home, and we again open our foster space to another one who needs that same critical care. It is the generous monetary donations that help us to work with an amazing team of vets and technicians, which give these cats the care they need.
